






COMMISSION'S CARBON FOOTPRINT (EMAS PERIMETER)






















Environmental management: Leading by example

The European Commission long provided strong political leadership on environmental issues, including fighting climate change. It became in 2005 the first EU **Institution to achieve an EMAS registration** reducing the environmental impact of its everyday activities. Initially limited to Brussels, the scheme now includes its eight largest sites in Europe: Brussels, Luxembourg, JRCs Geel (Belgium), Petten (Netherlands), Seville (Spain), Karlsruhe (Germany), and Ispra (Italy), along with DG SANTE at Grange (Ireland). It recently included in its EMAS registration the 6 executive agencies and 4 Commission Representations in the Member States (Vienna, Valletta, Budapest, and Nicosia). Through EMAS the European Commission identifies, minimises, and mitigates the environmental impacts of its activities, delivering continuous improvement in environmental performance in line with the EU policies and regulations. Every year the European Commission publishes its results in an Environmental Statement. This brochure presents some highlights of the latest results.

On 5 April 2022, the Commission adopted a Communication on its Greening with the aim to become climate neutral by 2030 as announced by the President Ursula von der Leyen in the context of the Green Deal.
